

Dear Advanced Academics Student,


Future second grade students received the book titled *Violet the Pilot* that is an innovative introduction to our 2020-2021 Advanced Academics curriculum theme. Students may use this book or select another book/story of their choice to complete <u>one</u> of the projects below. NEW STUDENTS to the program may select an online story or book to read based on inventions to complete <u>one</u> of the projects below.

The project is to show a creation made by the student and this assignment will be **graded based on the student's creativity.** Projects will be graded based on spelling, grammar, punctuation, effort, organization, creativity, and originality. **All projects are due the first day of school. Please be ready to present your project on the first day of school to your new class. No late projects will be accepted!**

Write a song, poem, or rap to sell your invention that includes some kind of rhythm. You must include the name of your invention, a description of your invention, why your invention is so important, how much it costs, and how your invention helps other people. You can publish your song, poem, or rap on a sheet of paper or use a scrapbook page up to 12 X 12. Decorate your masterpiece.

Create a magazine cover page that includes: the name of your invention (which can be the title of your magazine), a diagram of your invention with at least 3 labels, a juicy phrase that sells your invention, invent and write a store name of where your invention can be bought, and include the price of your invention. Decorate the cover. The magazine cover page must be the size of a sheet of paper, 8 ½ X 11.

Used recycled materials found at home to create a 3D model of your new invention. Write on an index card the following: name of your invention, the reason why your invention is important, and explain why people need your invention. Glue the index card to your invention. Item can be up to 12 X 12.



- Parents can easily monitor their child's progress by creating a Free Reflex Parent Account. Use the instructions on the right to Create your Parent Account.

Create a Free Parent Account

To set up an account, you will need your child's Reflex login information: (teacher's Reflex Username, the name of the Reflex Class, and your child's Reflex Password).

- 1. Go to reflexmath.com/parent
- 2. Follow The onscreen instructions to create your free account.
- 3. Go to Parent Login.
- Once you are logged in, follow the instructions to add your child.
- 5. Once registered, launch the parent account at <u>Parent Login</u> and log into your new account. Enter your Username (your email address) and Password and click Login.
